Dear Judge Hochberg:

I am Co-Lead Counsel for the Direct Purchaser Class in the above-referenced litigation, and I write with regard to Class Counsel's motions for final approval of the proposed Settlement and Plan of Allocation, and for an award of attorneys' fees, costs and incentive awards to the named plaintiffs (respectively, the "Final Approval Motion" and "Fee and Incentive Award Motion").

In its order dated August 30, 2005, the Court instructed Class Counsel to make available to the Class materials to be filed in support of the Fee and Incentive Award Motion on October 12, 2005, prior the final date on which Class members could choose to opt-out of, or object to, the proposed Settlement. Accordingly, on October 12 I caused such material to be posted to the websites of Co-Lead Counsel, www.garwingerstein.com and www.cmht.com. Class Members had previously been informed through the Notice approved by this Court that this material would be available on those sites. This material includes affidavits prepared by Co-Lead Counsel and each individual Class Counsel detailing the history of the litigation and the work done by Class Counsel in prosecution this action and effectuating the Settlement.

In accordance with the August 30 Order, the Final Approval Motion and Fee and Incentive Award Motion will be filed with the Court on October 26, 2005. At that time, briefs in support of both motions will also be filed, in order to address the applicable legal standards for final approval of the Settlement and an awards of fees and incentive awards, and to address any objections filed by members of the Class. To date, there have been no objections to the proposed Settlement, or to the request for attorneys' fees, costs and incentive awards for the named plaintiffs.
